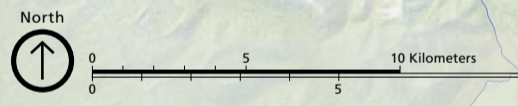

Driving Going-to-the-Sun Road
Vehicles over 21 feet (including bumpers) or over 8 feet wide (including mirrors) are prohibited between Avalanche Creek and Rising Sun, and North Fork Road beyond Polebridge Entrance Station. Rock overhangs may pose difficulties for vehicles over 10 feet tall in traveling west from Logan Pass to the Loop. Guided tours are available; check at a visitor center.
